

A three-day voyage to explore abundant nature and island culture NEW



Mt. Goishi

This three-day voyage sails through the bold scenery to the east of Onomichi. En route to an anchorage off the coast of Tamano in Okayama Prefecture on the first night, guntû passes by the Mizushima Industrial Complex and beneath the impressive silhouette of the Great Seto Bridge, a marvel of modern engineering. Guests may enjoy a close-up view of inherited traditional landscapes and industry producing soy sauce, noodles, and olive oil on Shodoshima, the rich culture of the more than 100 islands of the Bisan group, and the beautiful seascapes of the Shiwaku Islands, a hub of maritime networks for centuries. As guntû navigates through these storied waters, ponder the lives and work of past generations.



Schedule

1st Day	Depart from Bella Vista Marina (3:00 p.m.) → Onomichi Strait → Innoshima Bridge → Tomonoura → Kasaoka Islands → Great Seto Bridge → Kazurajima Strait → Anchor offshore at Tamano, Okayama
2nd Day	Depart from Tamano → Teshima → Mito Peninsula → Uchinomi Bay in Shodoshima → Bisan Strait → Great Seto Bridge → Shiwaku Islands → Anchor at Takuma Bay, Kagawa
3rd Day	Depart from Takuma Bay → Mushima → Kobijima → Hashirijima → Abuto Kannon → Utsumi Bridge → Momoshima → Arrive at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)

- Visit a stone quarry site on Shodoshima that supplied Osaka Castle
- Walk on Honjima, home to a traditional townscape constructed by Shiwaku carpenters
- Watch seaweed harvesting from a boat
