Centered on our home port of Onomichi, this route circles widely across the sea, as far as Omishima in the west and the Shonai Peninsula in the east. Schedule

1st Day	Depart from Bella Vista Marina (3:00 p.m.) → Mihara Strait → Okunoshima → Chigirijima → Akashi Strait → Anchor offshore at Omishima, Ehime
2nd Day	Depart from Omishima → Hanaguri Strait → Takaikamijima → Hiuchi Sea → Nio → Ibukijima → Shonai Peninsula → Anchor at Takuma Bay, Kagawa
3rd Day	Depart from Takuma Bay → Mushima → Kobijima → Tomonoura → Abuto Kannon → Momoshima → Arrive at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)
