

A four-day voyage to drift leisurely across western Setouchi NEW

Countless islands fill the waters to the west of guntū's home port in Onomichi. guntū is able to pass through narrow straits thanks to its small size, offering an up-close view of a unique seascape that melds Setouchi island scenery with modern industry. While the Seto Inland Sea appears placid, the tidal flows in these waters create strong currents. Like navigators in past eras, guntū constantly adjusts its route depending on the tides. Catch glimpses of the rhythms of local life from just off the shore of islands, as scenes of fishing and farming, bridges and ferries, and the faint glow of village lights flow past the windows of your suite. This route explores the classic Setouchi landscapes that remain west of Onomichi.



Schedule

1st Day	Depart from Bella Vista Marina (3:00 p.m.) → Onomichi Strait → Okunoshima → Itsuki Sea → Kutsuna Islands → Anchor offshore at Suooshima, Yamaguchi
2nd Day	Depart from Suooshima → Heigun Island → Iwashima → Kaminoseki Strait → Obatake Strait → Kutsuna Islands → Anchor offshore at Miyajima, Hiroshima
3rd Day	Depart from Miyajima → Hiroshima Bay → Ondo Strait → Sekizen Islands → Kurushima Strait → Tataru Bridge → Anchor offshore at Omishima, Ehime
4th Day	Depart from Omishima → Hanaguri Strait → Yuge Strait → Momoshima → Arrive at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)
