

A four-day voyage to drift leisurely across eastern Setouchi NEW



guntū drifts on serene waters

This route roams freely through the spacious waters between our home port in Onomichi and Shodoshima, offering a mix of the distinctive island-filled seascapes of Setouchi and the refreshment of a voyage on the open sea. More expansive than western Setouchi, this area offers sweeping views from onboard of the subtly shifting scenery of winter and spring in Setouchi. The refined cultural traditions that remain deeply rooted in Takamatsu and other local areas add another layer of depth to the journey. Enjoy a four-day experience that distills the essence of guntū's style of leisurely, care-free travel.



Schedule

1st Day	Depart from Bella Vista Marina (3:00 p.m.) → Utsumi Bridge → Abuto Kannon → Hashirijima → Shiraishi Strait → Manabejima → Anchor at Takuma Bay, Kagawa
2nd Day	Depart from Takuma Bay → Great Seto Bridge → Naoshima Strait → Ushimado → Hinase → Odeshima → Mito Peninsula → Anchor at Uchinomi Bay in Shodoshima, Kagawa
3rd Day	Depart from Uchinomi Bay → Ogijima → Great Seto Bridge → Shiwaku Islands → Kasaoka Islands → Bingo Sea → Anchor at Kitagishima, Okayama
4th Day	Depart from Kitagishima → Hashirijima → Yokoshima → Innoshima Bridge → Onomichi Strait → Arrive at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)
