

A four-day voyage to enjoy a special island feast

Departing September 24, 2026 (3 nights 4 days)

This special autumn route welcomes Ryohei Hayashi, owner and chef at Japanese restaurant Tenoshima in Aoyama, Tokyo, to serve a one-day-only special lunch menu. Hayashi trained at the venerable Kyoto restaurant Kikunoi before opening Tenoshima in 2018, and is passionate about passing down authentic Japanese culinary traditions. For the lunch excursion to Hayashi’s ancestral home of Teshima, the chef drew inspiration from how ancient people likely lived on these shores, creating a meal that reimagines ancient ways of eating for the present.

Curated with the Seto Inland Sea Folk History Museum, this route explores how geology shaped the distinctive seascape and local food cultures of Setouchi.

Enjoy a romantic voyage through time to Setouchi thousands of years ago.
