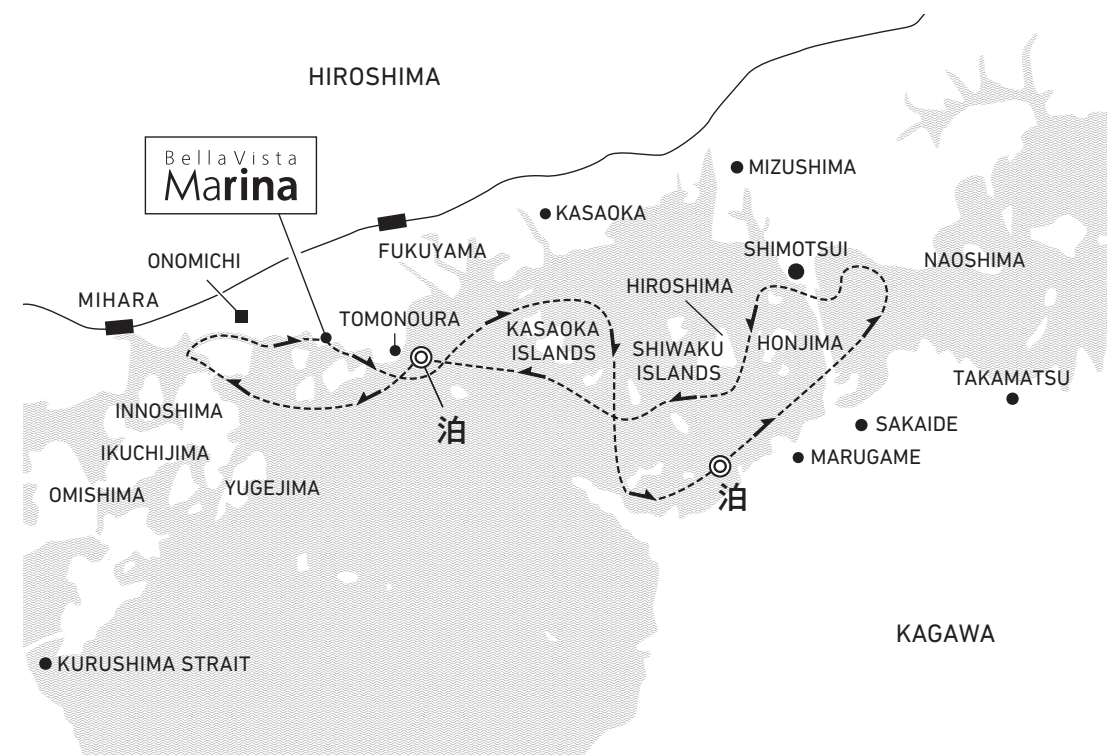




The Shiwaku suigun pirates flourished alongside a string of powerful lords over the centuries. Explore the waters they knew intimately and uncover remnants of their prosperity on this route. The many inhabited islands that fill the sea between guntū's home port in Onomichi and the Great Seto Bridge some 50 kilometers to the east remain home to simple but largely unknown cultural traditions. On the second day, we will take you to a hidden vestige of their prosperity on islands such as Awashima, home to Japan's first National Sailor School; Honjima, known for its intricate buildings crafted by the skilled Shiwaku carpenters; Teshima, where the fabled Kagawa Hontaka chili pepper is grown; or Kitagishima, a stone island famed as one of the three best quarries in Setouchi.



Schedule

Contents are subject to change without prior notice depending on the reservation date, the weather and sea conditions on the day.

1st Day	Departure from Bella Vista Marina (4:30 p.m.) → Pass through the Onomichi Strait → Pass the Innoshima Bridge and Abuto Kannon → Anchor offshore at Takuma, Kagawa
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Onomichi Strait

Almost like a river, the Onomichi Strait is a channel just 200 meters across at its narrowest point that separates central Onomichi and Mukaishima. Due to its location near the center of the Seto Inland Sea, it has long been a crucial port. The hillside townscape on the Honshu side, and the shipyards on the Mukaishima side create distinctive scenery.

2nd Day	Off-ship activity : A morning tour to Awashima → Pass the Great Seto Bridge → Off-ship activity : Visit to Honjima, Mushima or Kitagishima → Anchor offshore at Tomonoura
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3rd Day	Departure from off the coast of Tomonoura → Arrival at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)
