

A four-day voyage to encounter the old and new charms of islands

Eastward route (3 nights 4 days) : anchor offshore at Kitagishima, Shodoshima and Tomonoura

From home port in Onomichi, this four-day voyage travels as far as Shodoshima on a route featuring the best of eastern Setouchi. Discover islands' history and traditional industries, including a quarry on Kitagishima, famed for the quality of its granite; Shodoshima, the second-largest island in the Inland Sea; up-and-coming art islands Ogijima and Megijima; and Honjima, home to a traditional townscape constructed by Shiwaku carpenters.



Schedule

Contents are subject to change without prior notice depending on the reservation date, and weather and sea conditions.

1st Day	Departure from Bella Vista Marina (4:30 p.m.) → Onomichi Strait → Innoshima Bridge → Shiraishi Strait → Anchor offshore at Kitagishima
2nd Day	Off-ship Activities → Departure from off the coast of Kitagishima → Shiwaku Islands → Great Seto Bridge → Bisan Strait → Off-ship Activities → Anchor offshore at Shodoshima
3rd Day	Departure from off the coast of Shodoshima → Off-ship Activities → Yashima → Megijima → Off-ship Activities → Shiwaku Islands → Kasaoka Islands → Anchor offshore at Tomonoura
4th Day	Departure from off the coast of Tomonoura → Abuto Kannon → Momoshima → Arrival at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)

Tour includes : 3 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 3 dinners

Examples of off-ship activities on the second day

- Walk on Kitagishima, an island famed for its stone quarries
- Visit to the sacred mountain at Goishizan
- Visit to a 150-year-old soy sauce brewery

Examples of off-ship activities on the third day

- Walk on Yashima, home to a famous 12th century warrior
- Walk on Megijima, home to a demon legend
- Walk in Ritsurin Park and tea in a Daimyo garden
- Walk on Honjima, known for its traditional townscape
