#### What is included in the charter rate

- 5. Local coordination fee

# Application procedure

- (1) The charter process begins with a conversation. Please share with us what you would like to experience during your guntû charter voyage. We will manage your expectations and customize your itinerary.
- (2) After further conversations, please confirm the itinerary such as the departure date, travel days, route, content, etc.
- (3) Please submit an application sheet for the charter contract. A travel business partnership agreement is also required for this charter.
- (4) Please pay an application fee (50% of the total charter rate) within 7 business days after the application.
  - \*Please pay the reminder by 30 days prior to the tour.





Guntû is a floating hotel designed by award-winning Japanese architect Yasushi Horibe. It drifts on the gentle waters of the Seto Inland Sea. It was conceived as an "inn" where travelers can pass time upon the sea while enjoying the nature and culture of Setouchi. Under the symbolic gable roof, there are 19 wood-paneled cabins and cozy public spaces for relaxation. Relax as this space resembling a Japanese ryokan blends into the gentle scenery of Setouchi.

## Open Deck (Deck 3)

Located on the bow of the ship, the Open Deck is a perfect place to soak in the scenery ahead. We offer yoga lessons on the Open Deck as a charter option.



#### ○ The Café & Bar (Deck 3: 10 seats)

At the 10-seated U-shaped counter, you can enjoy your favorite drinks, from a cup of specialty coffee to guntû's signature cocktail.



#### ○ The Engawa (Deck 3)

Dressed in yukata with seasonal sweets and Japanese sake by your side, you can savor the slow flow of time in Japan. We offer zazen meditation experience as an option.



#### ○ The Lounge (Deck 3: 18 seats)

Enjoy seasonal Japanese sweets made in front of you along with local green tea and matcha tea as you gaze at the ship's trail. Japanese sweets are supervised by Joichiro Kita of Kashiya in Nara.



### ○ Spa Area (Deck 2)

Guntû Spa includes treatment rooms, communal baths with saunas, a gym with Technogym® equipment and a salon. For relaxation, Choukoku-Lymph® treatments and Japanese-style Nentai massage menus have been prepared to meet the mood and physical condition of each and every individual.



#### Cuisine

"What you want, as much as you want" is the concept of guntû dining. Our chefs cook seasonal specialties of Setouchi to meet your preferences. Savor the luxury of exceptional dining while floating on the sea. Special arrangements for your charter such as special course menus and table settings for parties are available.

### - Japanese cuisine & Japanese-style Western cuisine (Deck 3 Dining Room: 22 seats)

The dining room features Japanese cuisine supervised by Kenzo Sato from the Tokyo restaurant Shigeyoshi as well as Japanese-style Western cuisine called "Yoshoku". For Japanese cuisine, guests can choose your favorite ingredients from a wide variety of fresh fish, meat and vegetables, and select how they are cooked by our chefs. Special course menus are available for charter dinners. The capacity of the dining room for seated-style dinner is 22 guests.

#### - Sushi (Deck 3 Sushi Bar: 6 seats)

Behind the dining room, there is a six-seat sushi bar with a sea view. Our Setouchi-style sushi supervised by Nobuo Sakamoto of Nobu at Awajishima uses a sprinkle of natural Setouchi salt and citrus to bring out the essential sweetness of whitefish, shellfish, and octopus raised on the rich nutrition of the Inland Sea.







# The Seto Inland Sea and guntû's routes

Setouchi is a beautiful waterway that interweaves an archipelago of more than 700 islands. We offer more than 10 routes through eastern, western, and central Setouchi. You can choose your favorite route, or customize a route according to islands you want to visit and off-ship activities you want to experience. Going ashore on islands along the ship's route using our dedicated speed boats designed by Yasushi Horibe, you have a chance to visit places not normally available for sightseeing.

# -Guntû's routes

#### O Westward routes

Stretching from the islands of the Shimanami Kaido and Tobishima Kaido to the Kutsuna Islands and Kaminoseki, westward routes travel through waters rich with the romance of history, home to Miyajima's Itsukushima Shrine and Omishima's Oyamazumi Shrine. The routes navigate between islands separated by narrow "Seto" straits, letting you glimpse the scenery of everyday life in Setouchi up close.

Off-ship activities

Morning walk at Miyajima and visit to Itsukushima Shrine, tour of terraced fields at Kashima, experience of the rapid currents of the Kurushima Strait, etc.

#### ○ Central routes

Central routes cruise through the waterways of the Shimanami Kaido, a chain of six islands linked by seven bridges, the Tobishima Kaido, a series of five islands linked on the west end to Kure, and Takuma Bay and the Shiwaku Islands in Kagawa. The central routes have features of both eastward and westward routes, condensing the delicate and bold, still and dynamic allure of Setouchi.

Off-ship activities

Walk at the port town of Tomonoura, scenic tour at Mitoyo, visit to Oyamazumi Shrine at the sacred island of Omishima, etc.

#### Eastward routes

Passing through the Kasaoka Islands and traveling beneath the Great Seto Bridge, eastward routes explore a region of islands rich with distinctive industry and culture, from the art islands of Naoshima and Inujima to Shodoshima. The waters of the eastern Inland Sea are more open than the west, offering impressive views of dynamic structures like the Great Seto Bridge and wide vistas of islands and towns in the distance.
