



About Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19

At guntû, we are taking constant precautions to reduce the potential for spread of COVID-19 according to our own rigorous guidelines, which received a “Biosafety Management System” certification on July 3, 2020. Our guidelines are based on COVID-19 prevention guidelines established by the Japan Passengerboat Association and the Japan Hotel Association.

Biosafety Management System

The global COVID-19 pandemic has had a major impact on the maritime industry, particularly on cruise ships. The Japanese maritime association ClassNK quickly established its Safety Management System, a standard for measures to prevent infectious diseases on ships. The Biosafety Management System is a collaborative effort between ClassNK and the Japan Oceangoing Passenger Ship Association based on the input of experts, as well as guidelines from international organizations and related industries, and is designed to ensure safety and peace of mind for ship users.

Guntû’s measures to reduce the risk of infection

Basic measures taken throughout the ship

Use of air purifiers / Regular ventilation of interior spaces / Ensuring distance between people (social distancing) / Suspension of book and magazine viewing

Measures to prevent infections among the crew

Daily check of temperature and physical health / Frequent hand washing, gargling, hand sanitizing / Masking / Periodic PCR and antigen tests / Washing and disinfection / In-house seminars on measures to prevent infection / Coordination with outside organizations to prepare for emergencies


Other infection prevention measures

- Seating in the Dining Room is reservation-only in order to ensure social distancing.
- Some beauty treatments and massage services have been modified to ensure safety.
- Cleaning and turndown service in your cabin will be conducted according to your wishes.



To guntû passengers

- We ask all guests to disinfect hand upon entering the dining area.
- Please wear a mask while on board or participating in off-ship activities, except when eating, bathing, or spending time inside your cabin.
- When departing for and returning from off-ship activities, we ask for your cooperation with a thermal camera temperature check and hand disinfection at the sub-entrance, and that you wear a mask during excursions from the ship. In order to maintain social distance during off-ship activities, earphones will be provided to listen to the guide. Activities on board/on shore may be subject to change or cancellation depending on the situation.



Guntû will continue to implement rigorous measures in order to reduce the risk of infection for passengers and crew members as part of our Biosafety Management System, based on thorough consideration of the risks of contact and airborne spread.
