Swordsmith

Schedule

1st Day	Departure from Bella Vista Marina (4:30 p.m.) → Bingo Sea → Kasaoka Islands → Great Seto Bridge → Anchor offshore at Tamano, Okayama
2nd Day	Departure from off the coast of Tamano → Naoshima → Takamatsu Port → Hinase → Shiwaku Islands → → Anchor offshore at Takuma Bay, Kagawa One off-ship activity planned
3rd Day	Departure from off the coast of Takuma Bay → Awashima → Kasaoka Islands → Abuto Kannon → Arrival at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)

Tour includes : 2 breakfasts, 1 lunch, 2 dinners

*On second day, an off-ship activity is planned for either the morning or afternoon.

*The destinations of off-ship activities change depending on day of departure. Details will be shared after boarding.

On this route to experience Setouchi's traditional culture and craftsmanship, guntū departs Bella Vista Marina and passes by the glowing lights of the Mizushima industrial complex before anchoring off the shore of Tamano in Okayama Prefecture. The next day includes an experience of traditional arts such as bonsai or lacquerware in Takamatsu, or depending on the season, the harvest of seaweed. Soak in the view of the sunset and the Great Seto Bridge before spending a final night aboard guntū in Takuma Bay.

- Dye temari balls with vivid geometric patterns
- Make dried sweets with Meiji-era wooden molds
- Harvest seaweed at a seaweed farm
- Visit a swordsmith in Osafune, a swordmaking town for 700 years
- Make a tray landscape at Japan's center of Kuromatsu bonsai
