Miyajima

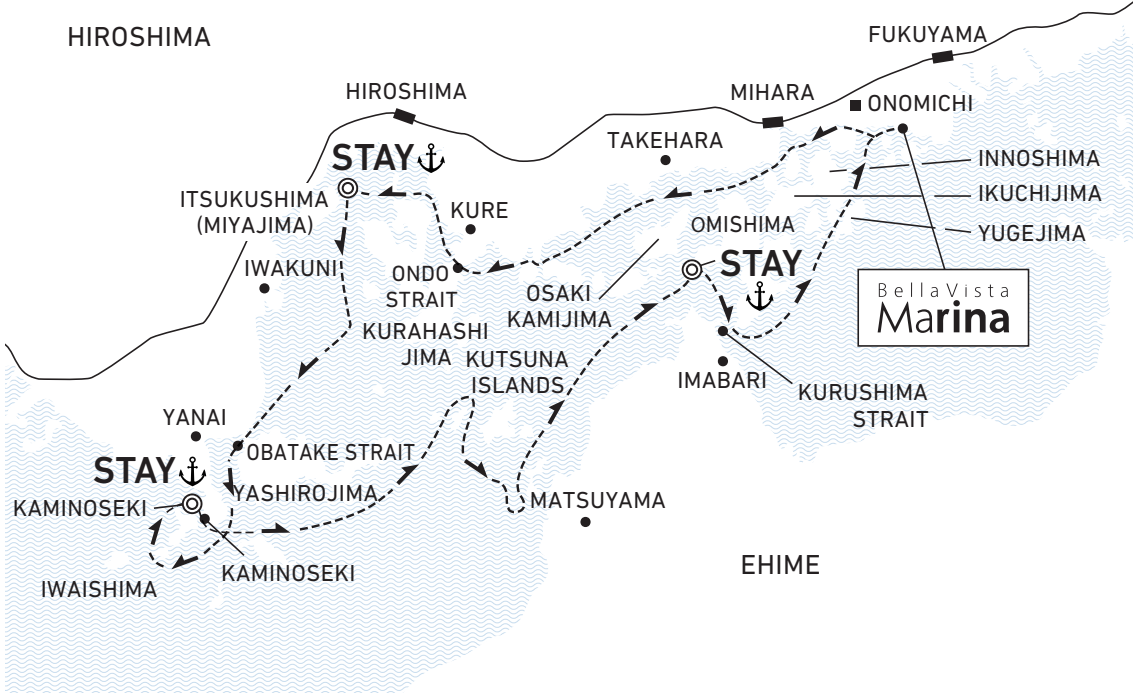
Schedule

1st Day	Departure from Bella Vista Marina (4:30 p.m.) → Onomichi Strait → Mihara Strait → Chigirijima → Akinada Bridge → Ondo Strait → → Anchor offshore at Miyajima, Hiroshima
2nd Day	Departure from off the coast of Miyajima → Miyajima Strait → Atatajima → Obatake Strait → → Kasasajima → Heigun Strait → Iwaishima → Anchor offshore at Kaminoseki, Yamaguchi One off-ship activity planned
3rd Day	Departure from off the coast of Kaminoseki → Kaminoseki Strait → Suooshima → Tsuwajijima → → Nakajima → Tsurushima → Itsukishima → Anchor offshore at Omishima, Ehime One off-ship activity planned
4th Day	Departure from off the coast of Omishima → Kurushima Strait → Hakatajima → Yuge Strait → Momoshima → Arrival at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)

Stretching from Onomichi in Hiroshima to Kaminoseki in Yamaguchi, this four-day cruise is a chance to enjoy the best of the western Seto Inland Sea. Weaving through a number of Setouchi's distinctive narrow straits, including the Onomichi Strait and Ondo Strait, guntû explores waters that have been criss-crossed since ancient times by fishermen and merchants who prayed to deities on many islands for protection at sea. Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima, worshipped by the powerful lord Taira- no-kiyomori in the 12th century, is one such place. The ship traces routes that have been at the heart of commerce for centuries, passing places such as Yanai, a port town that flourished as a trading hub, allowing you to enjoy Setouchi's timeless scenery and the beauty of its countless islands.

- Walk among the stone-walled lanes of Iwaishima
- Visit to Hannya Temple, connected to various legends of the sea
- Walk around Yanai, a key town in the trading network of the Inland Sea
- Visit to Oyamazumi Shrine on Omishima, protector of mountains, sea and warriors
- Walk among the terraced fields of Kashima
- Experience of the famous tidal currents of the Kurushima Strait
- Walk on Heigun Island, a base of the Kawano pirates
