

A three-day voyage to explore abundant nature and island culture NEW

This route strings together old and new charms nestled in the magnificent scenery of eastern Setouchi. Off-ship activities include visits to contemporary art on world-famous Naoshima or Teshima, as well as going ashore on Shodoshima, home to both beautiful natural landscapes and industries proudly passed down over generations. Returning westward, guntū passes beneath the Great Seto Bridge, whose mighty appearance is a monument to modern engineering, before sailing through the scenic seascape of the Shiwaku Islands, a node in maritime networks since ancient times. This three-day journey gives a taste of both the heritage of the past and the future of Setouchi that is always changing with the times.

Schedule

1st Day	Departure from Bella Vista Marina (4:00 p.m.) → Onomichi Strait → Innoshima Bridge → Mizushima industrial complex → Great Seto Bridge → → Naoshima Strait → Anchor offshore at Tamano, Okayama
2nd Day	Departure from off the coast of Tamano → Teshima → Shodoshima → Bisan Strait → → Great Seto Bridge → Shiwaku Islands → Anchor offshore at Takuma Bay, Kagawa Two off-ship activity planned
3rd Day	Departure from off the coast of Takuma Bay → Kasaoka Islands → Tomonoura → Abuto Kannon → → Momoshima → Arrival at Bella Vista Marina (11:00 a.m.)
